



Terms of Service – Autism Society Alberta Membership

As a member, you'll gain access to updates, resources, and opportunities to get involved. Together, we can make a real impact and help drive positive change.

Membership

To be a member of Autism Society Alberta, an individual must be 18 years of age or older.

Only members in good standing, will have voting privileges.

The membership list for Autism Society Alberta is updated annually and runs from September 1st until August 31st of the following year.

Fees

There is no fee for membership.

Resignation, suspension and removal

A member may resign by written notice (electronic or hardcopy) addressed to the Board Members through the Secretary.

The Board has the right to discipline any member if they break the rules, harm the Society's reputation, or for any other reason the Board thinks is fair. The Board can choose to:

- Suspend the member's rights for a certain period,
- End the person's membership, or
- Take any other action they believe is appropriate.

A member's membership can be cancelled if at least two-thirds of the voting members approve a resolution at a meeting specifically called for that purpose. The member must be given at least 21 days' notice of the meeting and the proposed cancellation, and they (or their representative) must be allowed to speak at the meeting. Notice can be sent by mail, email, fax, or other means using the contact details on record.
