1. Where to look?

2. Setting up the viewing: What to say?

Search platforms often have an option where you can send a message to the landlord directly or call (you may have to create an account to use this option). I recommend sending a message and calling. Try writing a script similar to the below, so that you communicate confidently and clearly:

I have the following availability: _____. Let me know what date and time works for you and I will try and accommodate.
